



For His Increase Building Venture Summary

WHY BUILD?

***For the purpose of maximizing opportunities to fulfill our mission:
Love God, Love people, Make disciples.***

1. Visibility, a convenient location and space to better reach-out to our River Valley community.
2. Dedicated space to disciple junior high and high school students.
3. Improved capacity and learning environment for children.
4. Improved parking that removes parking challenges for members and guests.
5. Outdoor space for children's playground, youth activities, church gatherings, outreach events and youth/college student hangout.
6. Intentional space to encourage fellowship and relationship building.
7. Positions our church for future growth and ministry opportunities.

WHERE WILL WE BUILD?

On the 10-acres we own on the southeast corner of Phoenix and Parkway.

WHAT WILL WE BUILD?

16,000 ft² building with dedicated children's area, large fellowship lobby, 300-plus capacity auditorium/sanctuary and separate youth building. (Current building is 6,700 ft²)

WHEN WILL WE BUILD?

When two things happen:

- 1) Current land debt paid-off (owe \$278,038 as of 10/17/16)
- 2) \$1,000,000 cash on-hand in our building fund. (This amount is approximately ½ of total building cost of 2.6 million minus assumed value of \$300,000 for current building.)

HOW WILL WE FUND IT?

Intentional and sacrificial giving to the building fund above or beyond normal monthly giving.

WHAT ARE THE NEXT STEPS?

1. **Remember: *a church is not about a building; it is about people.*** We must be careful that a building program does not consume us nor impede current ministries.
2. **Immediately start giving to the building fund.** Take time to prayerfully consider what God is asking you to do and perhaps sacrifice to help fund this venture. No commitment cards or pressure. (*Can give to the building fund online or by writing "building fund" on the memo line of your check.*)
3. **Continue to fulfill our mission** while maximizing our current facilities for God's glory and fame.
4. **Pray** with an expectant attitude to see what God will do and how He will use us to further His Kingdom *For His Increase!*
